Finding repertoire for young pianists can be a challenge and requires many hours of research. Bonnie will explore all stylistic periods that have something of value to offer, whether students aim to perform as soloists or in ensembles. She will focus on standard classical repertoire and collections. Some method books will be included. **Teaching and practice techniques will be demonstrated, and she will perform recommended music.** She will also initiate dialogue regarding editions.

A handout will include a comprehensive, level-based repertoire list, with commentary.

Bonnie Kellert is a widely known performer, teacher, lecturer, mentor, adjudicator and master class presenter. She is also a contributor for *KeyBoard Companion* and the *Piano Pedagogy Forum*. A scholarship student of Leon Fleisher, she has developed prize-winning students who have performed in master classes for Ruth Laredo, Susan Starr, Brian Ganz and Marvin Blickenstaff; for Leon Bates at the MTNA National Convention in D.C.; and at three MSMTA Conventions -for Thomas Mastroianni, Alexander Peskanov and Ingrid Clairfield.
